The sun shone and you turned out in your hundreds. Our aim was to make the Fete a community event and, from the comments received, I think we can officially declare it a success. Over £3,000 was raised which will be used to buy equipment for the Village Hall, support for the football club and to fund the start up costs for the new youth club. A donation is also being made to Help For Heroes.

There was a huge learning curve to organising our first event which was complicated by Wiltshire County Council 'hijacking' all of our advertising boards! Following liberation they were safely relocated on private property, and proved to be very popular.

## How Good Is Your Broadband??

We have had a broadband connection since it was first enabled in this area over 4 years ago.

Up until March this year the service was pretty reliable with speeds around the 2 Mbps mark. However since then the speed has declined steeply - some days no better than dial up. Also, there seems to be frequent disconnections which means the modem/router has to be re-set. The decline seemed to start after BT did some line maintenance in Coombe Lane - however this may be just a coincidence.

Needless to say I have had an ongoing dialogue with my ISP these past months. On several occasions they have got BT to 'reset our bRAS profile' (which I understand can get stuck, resulting in an unnecessarily low broadband speed) - this has resulted in a short term increase back to 2Mbps or thereabouts. However after a week or so it slides back down again.

Anyhow, before I rip the house wiring apart, buy a new modem/router, change ISP and pay BT to come and do tests, I thought it might be instructive to see how others are doing in and around Enford. Hence this survey.

If you would like to participate, please let me have the information listed below (sometime during the next couple of weeks) and I will publish the results of the survey in the next Newsletter.

1. Who is your internet service provide (ISP)?
2. Are there any ISP limits set on your broadband speed (eg. some packages may be limited to 512Kbps or 1Mbps so, no matter how good your connection, you won't be able to exceed these speeds).
3. What street do you live in?
4. What is the average download speed achieved using the speed tester website at <<http://www.top10-broadband.co.uk/speedtest/>>

## More Than 80 Wiltshire Walks To Download And Print FREE!
