As I write we are in the grip of winter, and I urge you instil a sense of responsibility in your children when throwing snowballs. It is a delight to see young people throwing snowballs, but all too often people go too far, throw ice with the snow, throw snowballs at complete strangers, and use the snow as an excuse for anti social behaviour. What may be fun between young friends can be terrifying for the elderly. Elsewhere in Wiltshire we have had a report of quite old youths on the top of a multi-storey car park throwing snowball at pensioners.

**BROADBAND IN ENFORD (steve@becker.globalnet.co.uk)**

In the last report I mentioned my 6-month (unsuccessful) campaign to get my Internet Service Provider (ISP) to rectify the appallingly low speed (0.13Mbps) we had been getting. Well, in addition to the poor broadband, voice conversation was also beginning to suffer badly from noise on the line.

Eventually we decided to call in a BT engineer however, having noted that BT will charge a fee if the problem is with your home installation rather than the BT line, first I checked our home appliances. I did this by disconnecting everything then re-connecting one thing at a time, and testing each appliance on each phone socket in the house. As the noise was present on every handset on every socket, it seemed fairly likely that the BT line was at fault rather than the house.

I went on-line (BT.com) to report the fault, wrote a few notes about the problems we had experienced, booked an engineer visit for the following morning and left it at that. About an hour later my wife, who was talking to someone on the phone at the time, said it was like someone had flicked a switch and turned off the noise that had been plaguing us for months. Needless to say, when the engineer visited the following morning he could find nothing wrong with the line. My wife told him about her experience the previous day, and asked whether it was possible someone had already fixed the problem remotely - he agreed that it was possible but didn't seem keen to discuss how or by whom. Within a couple of days broadband speed returned to 2Mbps, which is what we used to get before the problems started - it has stayed there ever since.

We got billed £125 for the engineer visit - I was half expecting this would happen, even though it was obviously a line fault and not therefore our liability. I went back to the BT website and filed a complaint - BT didn't argue, and immediately agreed to refund the money.

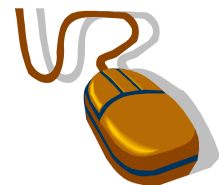
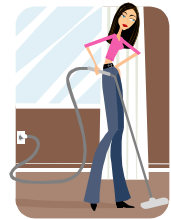

It could make a difference.

**SALISBURY PLAIN TRAINING AREA  
NEWS SHEET  
February 2010**



This forecast shows our planned training. Unfortunately operational requirements mean that dates and times can change. The warning flags and signs show the actual range danger areas on a given day. Late night firing times Tues, Thurs and Sat March to October 2330hrs and November to February 2100hrs inclusive.

Any general comment about military training should normally be made through Parish Councils to the Liaison Officer nominated by the appropriate Garrison Headquarters. Any specific complaint should be made in writing or if urgent by telephone as shown below:

**TRAINING:** A major pre-operational deployment training exercise involving 4 Mechanised Brigade is to take place on Salisbury Plain during the period 1st - 14th February 2010. The majority of activity will be centred on the Plain and surrounding military facilities. It will involve up to 3,500 soldiers and Royal Marines at any one time as well as some 430 wheeled and 70 tracked vehicles. A variety of helicopters, including Chinooks will participate in the exercise along with a small number of fast jets and C130 Hercules aircraft. The deployment and recovery of ground troops and vehicles from unit base locations to Salisbury Plain training area will be carefully controlled in order to minimise the impact on civilian traffic. Police and the AA Road Watch will be made aware of convoy (up to a maximum of 10 vehicles) routes and timings. 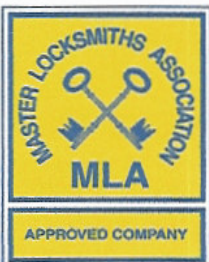

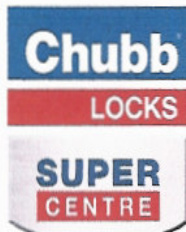
