*Dear Friends,*

The other day, a member of the Confirmation class asked the question “how do we know the exact date of Jesus’ birth?”

“Well, we don’t,” was my answer; years, months and days were not as we know them today.

If someone were to ask what happened in England on 6<sup>th</sup> September 1752, the answer would be nothing. In fact there are no dates 4<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> September in that year. The day after 3<sup>rd</sup> September was the 15<sup>th</sup>.


The reason for this was that our calendar had been made in Roman times and there was a very slight miscalculation. By 1752 the calendar was 11 days out and the government of the day felt they had to do something about it and decided to lose 11 days. This, and a slight adjustment in leap years would put matters right.

The result was that there were riots all over the country by people who felt that their lives had been cut short and who wanted the days put back. They were heard to say “It isn’t fair! Why should I lose 11 days!”

Many things in life are not fair and it is one of life’s lessons we have to learn. Some people always have more than their fair share and others lose out, but the important thing is not to feel sorry for ourselves. We have to try and overcome our difficulties and our disadvantages.

Dear Mrs Young,

I would like to thank you and the people of Enford and the surrounding villages for your wonderful efforts in raising £250 for our Haiti Earthquake Appeal at your sales of jumble and books. We assure you that your money will go directly towards helping the ongoing relief effort in Haiti.

Four months on from the devastating 7-magnitude earthquake in Haiti, we're continuing to assist families and children as they attempt to recover from the disaster and rebuild lives. We're providing emergency assistance to 800,000 people, among them 470,000 children. Of particular concern is the health and well-being of children as the rains have begun, swamping temporary settlements and increasing the risk that infectious diseases may take hold among vulnerable populations. In addition, we are delivering food and clean water, building water distribution points and latrines and working to promote good hygiene practices. We continue to expand our health and nutrition programmes. Our mobile health teams in Port au Prince, Leogane and Jacmel treat scores of patients, screen children for malnutrition, deliver babies, provide vaccinations and visit pregnant women and those who have recently given birth. Other life saving and life improving activities include livelihood programmes to help families improve their economic status while also bettering communities, child friendly spaces where children can regain a sense of structure and normalcy, and education assistance providing tents for temporary classrooms and educational material and supplies

## LOCAL POLICING

I am looking forward to meeting many of you at the East Chisenbury river restoration project in June.

It is reported that Southern Wiltshire is experiencing a rise in the number of thefts of mobile phones. It is a considerable help to our investigations if the phone's IMEI number is known, so please make a note of it. Also there is a system whereby a phone or any other serial numbered item can be registered centrally, and at no cost. Visit [Immobilise.Com](http://Immobilise.Com) and record your property details. It will aid tracing the property if it is lost or stolen.

Local incidents have included unauthorised credit card transactions in Enford and theft from a motor vehicle in Haxton. Further afield there has been a theft of a mobile phone from a handbag in Netheravon and a burglary in Collingbourne Ducis, where the offenders took car keys and other items, which were loaded into the victim's car and taken to Merseyside where the vehicle was abandoned. Also there has been a theft from a landfill site in Everleigh and the savaging of a dog by other dogs in Chute. You are asked to ensure that dogs are kept under control

## HIGHWAY NEWS MAY 2010

### **The A345 Road Surface Conditions from Enford through to Netheravon**

After persistent lobbying to the Council and the Area Boards of Tidworth and Pewsey we can now inform you that this stretch of the A345 is now on the Highways programme for resurfacing this year. This is excellent news of course, but with this new road surface we may find an increase of vehicle speed.

### **The A345 West Chisenbury and Newtown Request for a Speed Limit Reduction**

We have again written to the Cabinet Minister for Highways for Wiltshire Council. Councillor Dick Tonge regarding the recent Speed Limit Review for "A" & "B" roads. This was also copied to the newly elected member for this area the Rt Hon Claire Perry. We feel we have a strong case regarding the A345 due to its past history and the consistent number of road traffic accidents which have resulted in the A345 having to be closed to clear damaged vehicles and HGVs off of the highway. We will pursue this until we have a suitable conclusion.

### **Speeding and Enforcement**

We are still lobbying the Authorities for the reinstatement back to full strength of the Highway and Traffic division to enforce the law on those drivers who ignore speed limit zones, highway signs and those who drive at excessive speeds.

### **Enford Community Speed Watch**

This coming August, Enford will have been carrying out this scheme for the community since 2008. We have made a huge impact on the A345 at the 30mph "Gateway Zone". We now have four new volunteers in Steve Becker, Councillor Michael Fay, Councillor Bruce Carter and David Harbottle and we thank them for their volunteer support for this worthwhile project scheme.

### **The Swan Accident**

As you must all be aware this situation is still ongoing and we have no intention of closing this unresolved question of the non existence of the "Stopping Officers" report. We were led to believe by the police from the onset that there was a "Stopping Officers" report when the offending vehicle was stopped on the A345 at Durrington with a piece of the Swan Sign's wood structure sticking out of the top of the vehicle. We were told that the driver was allowed to go on his way after giving a reasonable excuse for leaving the scene of an accident without stopping and exchanging details.

After many requests to the police for a copy of this report, we were eventually told that to obtain this report under the freedom of information act it would cost £70.00. A cheque for this amount was raised and sent with a covering letter. After a considerable amount of time and then a phone call made to the police, the cheque was subsequently returned by post with a letter that said, "Only a pocket note book entry existed", and this said, at 14.35hrs on the 28<sup>th</sup> May 2008 a check was made on a Ford Iveco (Reg No given) which had failed to stop after a collision in Enford. Details were obtained and documents were all in order. No reasonable excuse was given in this vague report or the details of this police officer. We find all of this ambiguous and the situation goes on to find out the truth regarding this costly accident of £20k to Enford.

### **C32 Coombe/Enford/Littlecott and East Chisenbury. Traffic Calming**

We have managed to get the Council to install 30mph Ground Roundels and Slow Down signs within the Parish area. They have also sited the height restriction signs at all entrances to the C32 to protect the new Swan sign structure. We will soon be able to request another "Metro Loop" to be sited somewhere within the 30mph Zone of Enford Village (Long Street). If we are successful with this, we will then be able to add this area to the Enford Community Speed Watch Scheme, which will then give us three sites to operate from and then make an impact on the C32 for Traffic Calming.

### **The A345 Heavy Goods Vehicles using the road as a "Through Route"**

The A338/A346/A345 working group led by Wiltshire Councillor Charles Howerd, is now presenting the group's document to Wiltshire Council for approval and after this it will be presented to the Minister For Transport at the DfT for consideration to De-Prime the A338 which will then mean that restrictions will be put on the A345 regarding HGV "Through Traffic". This situation is tied in with the Parish Council's letters of request to Wiltshire Council's Cabinet Minister, Councillor Dick Tonge regarding the "Speed Limit" Review. You may like to know that the recent Metro Count Loop that was deployed on the A345 this March for 7 days, resulted in a count of 33,972 vehicles. In March 2009 for the same period it was 21,831. This is a huge increase on the previous year. No wonder the road wears out and is widened by stealth and that the side verges and residents' properties are damaged.

**The A345 Compton Request for an extra Bus Stop .**

We have not given up on this situation, even though we have been told by Wilts and Dorset Bus, that they think it is not safe to site a bus stop in this area. Our argument is that the whole road is unsafe for vehicles so pedestrians requesting public transport to travel is a priority.

**The A345 30MPH Zone New Buildings (West Side)**

Since 2006 we have been pressing the Council for a "Footpath" from the entrance of New Buildings (West Side) 50 metres in length to the bus stop opposite (East Side) by the field gate. We are pleased to inform you that this went before the Transport Working Group for Tidworth and is due before the next Tidworth Area Board Meeting for ratification for funding, which we understand is a formality. So hopefully we have got the "Footpath" that is so sorely needed for all of the occupants of New Buildings Enford. This all started when Ken Monk our Parish Chair and myself visited County Hall Trowbridge in March 2006 to ensure that our request for the 30MPH Gateway Treatment for the A345 at Enford was approved. This small badly needed footpath was on the agenda then but was way down the pecking order. We can now put this down to another Parish Council success by way of badgering and rattling cages and making ourselves unpopular and not easy on the ear drums. Since writing this report we can confirm that the application went before the Tidworth Area Board 17/5/10 and has been passed for the laying of the footpath.

**The A345 30MPH "Gateway Zone"**

We trust that when the resurfacing takes place that this treatment area will also be fully renewed .

**The New Village Bus Shelter**

This shelter came about due to the pure hard work of Enford Parish Councillor Martin Webb. We would like to thank him for this and we trust that all those that use this new Parish amenity will take comfort when either waiting for a bus or when the weather is bad .

Finally, I would like to say a big Thank You to Wiltshire Councillor Charles Howerd, who has given us an enormous amount of support regarding various Parish issues.

We thank you Charles; it is appreciated by the Parish Council and the Residents of Enford.

The local schools and units make the most of their opportunity to use the Plain in the last 2 weeks as 16 Brigade prepare for their large Exercise in July.

**REPAIRS TO BULFORD BRIDGE AND CIVILIAN USE OF MILITARY BRIDGES OVER THE RIVER AVON**

1. Bulford Bridge will be closed for some time while major structural repairs are undertaken. As a consequence an increased number of people are using the military bridges:
  - a. near Brigmerston (between Charlie (C) and Charlie 1 (C1) tank crossings) and
  - b. betwixt Fittleton and Fifield (between Bravo (B) and Bravo 1 (B1) tank crossings).

These two routes are not Public Rights of Way. Although Commander Defence Training Estate Salisbury Plain does not wish to deny the public their use when training is not taking place the public may be stopped from using them during military exercises.
3. There have been a number of incidents of "road rage" when individuals were told that training was taking place and that they may have to wait sometime. Many drivers are also using excessive speed on these narrow routes and endangering troops and civilians alike.
4. Please be aware that the bridges may be closed to the public for prolonged periods and if your journey is "time critical" please take the sign posted diversion route.

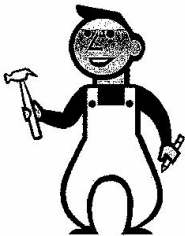

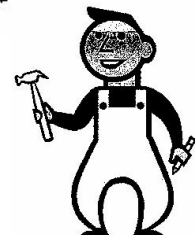
