"My steady weight loss went from pounds to stones"



Natalie was a complete sceptic when it came to diets and weight loss groups; she was resigned to the fact that after 11 years of being fat that was her life! At the age of 28, Natalie gave birth to her first child and with the added complication of having to take steroids; her weight ballooned to a hefty 15 stone.

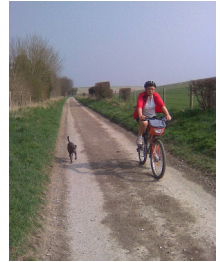
"I remember going out to purchase new trousers and feeling quite excited. I tried on several size 20s but none felt right. Mum handed me a size 22 and said "just try it." To my absolute horror they fitted beautifully; I didn't feel beautiful and broke down in tears." Natalie recalled this sad memory.



Natalie went on to have another child to complete her family. After 5 years she was taken off the steroids and an alternative used. This without even trying reduced her weight by a stone and her self-esteem improved, she became more active taking up cycling and lots of walking. In 2008 the whole family had the opportunity to have a long holiday away in Antigua visiting family. Natalie's loving and supportive mother, Lisa spoilt her and bought several new outfits so Natalie would feel and look great. Lisa told me why she wanted to do this for her daughter.

"It doesn't matter how big you are, you can still look smart and look good, it just takes a bit more time and effort because you don't have the same amount of choices when you're size 18-20"

Returning from Antigua with lots of photos Natalie could see she had to do something. She took up swimming lessons and started swimming regularly 3-4 times a week improving her fitness but still not losing weight. In April 2009 Lisa asked her daughter to take her to an Amesbury Slimming World Group because she wanted a little help to lose ½ a stone.



"I was fast approaching 40 and would have to drive mum there, wait for her and bring her home, so I decided to join. My steady weight loss went from pounds to stones in 5 months. The most amazing thing was that it wasn't a diet; never felt hungry and I could eat what I wanted including treats providing I followed the plan."

Natalie set her target where she was comfortable after losing 2stone 10pounds. Now she's completely turned her beliefs around to become a consultant herself.

"I want to be part of giving others the warmth, the support, the caring and the fun I received from Tracey and the members in Amesbury's group and to change the lives of others for the better. I'm still in target after a year and it's very manageable."

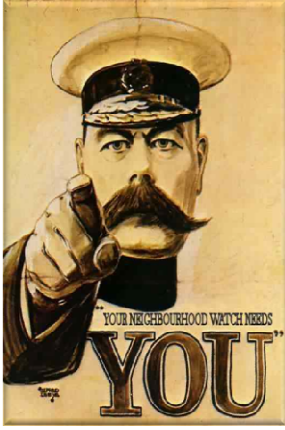

As explained in previous newsletters, the Enford NHW has been re-formed from scratch. There are still a number of vacancies, so if you would like to become a NHW coordinator then please get in touch. Tour of duty will be for one year, at the end of which you can either re-apply or stand down.

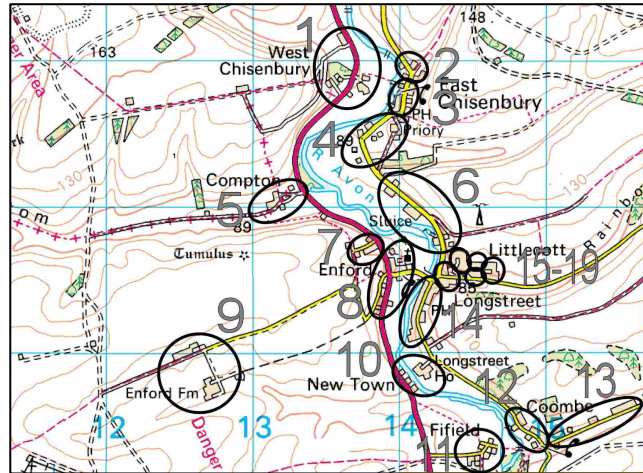
What's NHW All About? It's basically about encouraging people in the community to keep an eye out for each other. That means keeping an eye on each others' property when someone is away from home, keeping tabs on any strangers. Looking out for the elderly. Getting to know the young people. With our regular police increasingly thin on the ground, it makes sense to have a backup network in place.

What Do I Need In Order To Be A Coordinator? Most importantly, the ability to talk to people. A telephone and Email is also pretty much essential these

days. If you tend to be in and around the village during the daytime, then so much the better.

What Sort of Area Does A Coordinator Look After I have divided the parish up into 19 NHW schemes (see list below, and map right). Some of these contain only a couple of households, some (e.g. Grants Road) are quite large and may need to be split again.

LOCAL POLICING

After the recent murder in Swindon the following advice is given to young adults on and evening out:

Always make sure someone knows where you are going and what time you will be home.

Stick with friends when you are out and about.

Try not to walk alone.

When walking with friends, stick to well lit, busy areas and never be tempted to take short cuts through quiet or unlit areas.

There have been several thefts from cashpoint machines, which have been tampered with. Recently they have happened in Marlborough, Pewsey, Tidworth and Amesbury, two people have been arrested. Previously offenders fitted a Lebanese Loop to the card slot, and managed to steal the customer's card, having seen the PIN number being typed in. The latest scam is to glue some sort of bar across the cash dispenser. The banknotes come out, but the customer cannot see it. The machine is programmed to take back uncollected banknotes, but the glue prevents this from happening. The customer leaves, and the offender takes the banknotes. You can minimise the risk by going to a cashpoint during the working day, when the associated bank or shop is open, by using the same machine(you are more likely to spot something wrong), and by looking carefully at the machine before you put the card in (if it looks odd or smells of glue call the police).

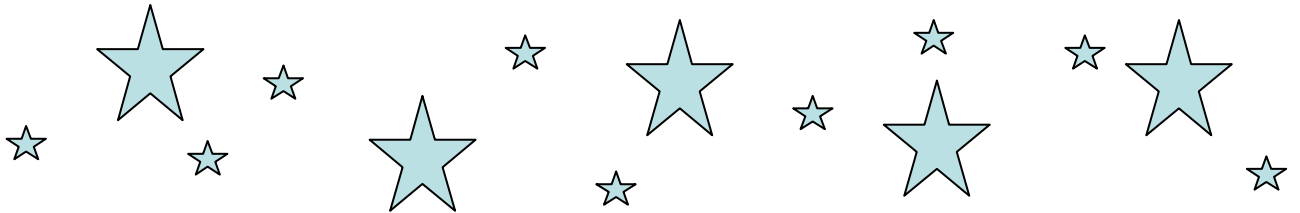

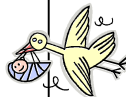

Take part in a sponsored walk for charity on Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd July 2011

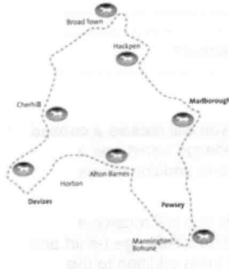
The Wiltshire Air Ambulance is a life saving asset for everyone in Wiltshire and is entirely dependant upon public funding each year to keep it flying.

Three local businesses are organising this event for the sixth year, having raised over £60,000 in total. Perfect for families, groups of friends, or for business teams, the White Horse Challenge is a great way to help this charity.

The Options:

1. Complete Challenge

A 55 mile walk starting in Devizes. You will walk a circular route around 7 of the white horses of Wiltshire and see some of the most beautiful countryside anywhere in England. Split over two days, the first day begins at Police HQ in Devizes heading towards Pewsey via Alton Barnes, and on to Marlborough. The second day begins in Marlborough and finishes back at Police HQ in Devizes where the Air Ambulance is based.



2. Relay Challenge

Split the distance amongst your team and undertake it as a relay...you decide how far each person walks.

3. One Day Challenge

Walk 1/2 the route by only participating on either Saturday or Sunday.

4. Family Challenge

A very popular option is the Family Challenge on the Sunday. This 7 mile route is perfect for families or groups of friends who would like to enjoy a few hours walking whilst helping to raise funds for this worthy cause.

Raising Money For Charity

We are aiming to raise as much as possible for the Wiltshire Air Ambulance which has running costs of £700,000 a year. The Air Ambulance has attended thousands of incidents over the years where its speed made all the difference to the patient or was able to reach an otherwise inaccessible location. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE

NEWSFLASH

Royal Engineers will close the military road between C crossing (A345) and C1 (C32) on **31 May** in order to construct an engineer bridge over the River Avon.

TRAINING ON SPTA

2 – 6 May sees Ex TEAM SPIRIT and the Armoured (Challenger 2) and Armoured Infantry (Warrior) courses from Land Warfare Centre training across the Plain. They will be joined by the Formation Recce course in CVR(T) on Ex BADGERS STRESS.

9 – 12 May will be relatively quiet. The main activity involves a squadron from 26 Armoured Engineer Regiment.

16 – 19 May sees the largest armoured exercise in the calendar (Ex LION STRIKE), an AS90 self propelled artillery battery exercise from the Royal School of Artillery and a squadron from 4 Logistics Support Regiment conducting combat logistic patrols on major routes across the Plain. There will be heavy use of tank crossings on the Tilshead to Chitterne road, A360 and A345.

Towards the end of the month 3 YORKS and 2 R WELSH each deploy a Warrior armoured infantry company for low level training on the western and eastern sections of the Plain respectively.

FIRING NOISE

The main source of noise complaints is the live firing of 155mm AS90 (Artillery System of the 90s) self propelled guns. The firing is closely managed to ensure that legal noise limits are not exceeded and disturbance is minimised. Although some may find the noise intrusive, it is well below legal limits.

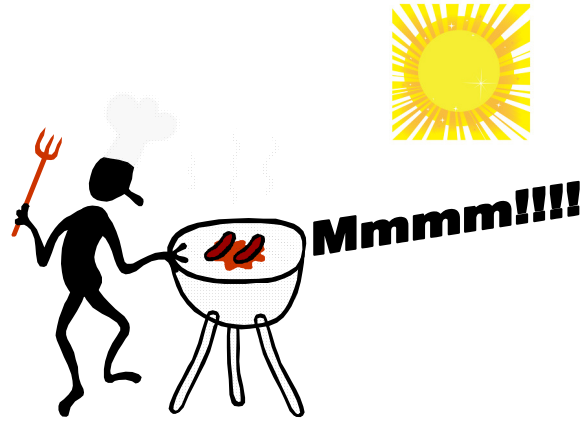

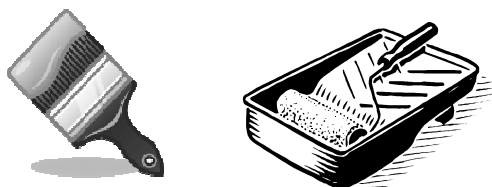
