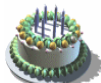

## Tales of a Morris Cowley Part Two

Last month covered the early months of a very unusual car, a 1928 Morris Cowley painted yellow and black

One redeeming feature of the car, and many others of that time was the strength of the bumpers; they were made of sprung steel and virtually indestructible. When I bought the car, there was a small amount of red paint on the end of the near-side front bumper. I asked about this and was told by other colleagues that the previous owner, an Australian nicknamed 'Pangy' arrived in the UK (from the outback?) unable to drive. Having acquired a provisional licence, he then set about bribing his friends to accompany him on so-called driving lessons. Most 'friends' only lasted about two trips, if that; Pangy's driving technique resembled that of a gorilla driving a tank. Anyhow, he progressed to the day when he decided it was time to try overtaking. His first target was a London bus. He stationed himself behind an unsuspecting one and in spite of urgings not to by his 'instructor', pulled out. Needless to say, something large was coming the other way and the gap between it and the bus was too narrow – even Pangy could see this. Making an instant decision, on the basis that hitting the bus going the same way as him was preferable to hitting an incoming vehicle, Pangy wrenched the wheel over to port and crashed into the bus's side. The front bumper neatly can-opened the bus along its length, doing no more damage to the car than acquiring the aforementioned red paint! History does not relate what the outcome of this event was.

Last month's tale described my first few months at Greenwich. Shortly after acquiring the car, we all moved to Portsmouth to start our technical classes in gunnery, navigation etc. We also started getting invitations to parties in London. This entailed getting up to London after classes finished, fortunately about 4.00 pm, and getting back in time to be on parade by 8:00 am, in uniform, and, with luck having breakfasted and even slept! Many of the parties finished at 2:00 am or later. We therefore had to have a transport plan whereby we took it in turn to drive three or four colleagues there and back. The faster cars used to aim to do Putney Bridge to Cosham roundabout (68 miles) down the A3 in 68 minutes, an average of 60 mph. I could not compete as my maximum was 55 mph. However it did pretty well and carried its share, often twice a week.

On one occasion as I was approaching Petersfield, the car started to wobble. Before I could stop there was a very nasty noise on the offside at the back and the car skidded to a halt but stayed upright. Clouds of black smoke rose from behind. I climbed out and found that the back wheel had come off and was now holding the car up under the wing; the tyre was smouldering from rubbing against the mudguard. I was alone on this trip but luckily, or so I thought, a passing colleague stopped to help. He was the one person on our course who no idea about cars at all. However, we managed to jack the Morris up and put the wheel back on. It had lost one wheel nut (there were only three on each wheel anyway) but we took one off another wheel that was well secured and all was well. We drove on, and back, later that night, about 100 miles, with no problems.

If we are on patrol, no one will answer, and there is no answer facility. Please do not call Tidworth Police Station to report a crime.

Please supervise teenagers on 31<sup>st</sup> October, certain traditions brought across from the USA have become anti social in their adoption here.

There have been several incidents involving dogs. They make wonderful pets, but some dogs have two personae, the playful obedient family member, and the wild wolf-like animal. A herd of sheep was attacked overnight last month, six of them had dog bites, and two were left with serious injuries. One afternoon two Staffies hunted down and attacked a Jack Russell, but when I saw them two days later they could not have been more friendly. Owners should keep their dogs under proper control, no dog should be allowed near sheep, and any breed which has pack hunting instinct should be kept muzzled in public. The farmer is allowed to shoot any dog caught "worrying" sheep. Any owner continually failing to control his or her dog may be barred from keeping dogs or be ordered to have the dog destroyed. Please keep control of your dog.

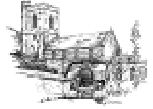

### STOP PRESS

**Imber Church Service of Remembrance.** Due to urgent training needs Imber Village will only be open from 1030 to 1230 on Saturday November 12<sup>th</sup>. Entry and exit will only be from Vedette Post 2 at Sack Hill, Warminster (beside Harman Lines).

### TRAINING ON SPTA

Training on the Plain in November will be stepped up a level. In the first week the Commando Training Centre Royal Marines conducts their Officers' Wing final exercise using Imber Ranges and Copehill Down Village. At the same time 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion Yorkshire Regiment, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion Grenadier Guards and 2<sup>nd</sup> Royal Tank Regiment conduct mission specific training across the Plain.

**6 - 10 November** sees the Land Warfare Centre mount a major armoured exercise SABRE'S THRUST across Imber and Larkhill Ranges.

**14 - 27 November** sees a simulation test exercise WESSEX THUNDER for 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion Royal Gurkha Rifles (1RGR) battle group involving some 1200 troops and 280 vehicles. 1 RGR will train in the light role using the Army Weapons Effect System and be equipped with operational wheeled armoured vehicles and supported by a company of Warrior armoured infantry vehicles. Disruption should be minimal but there will be day and night flying by APACHE and CHINOOK helicopters.

Activity peaks in the last 3 days of the month when Land Warfare Centre launches three major exercises: the armoured infantry RARDENS REVENGE, the close reconnaissance FOXES HAT and the Fire Support Group FINAL STRIKE. While the Royal School of Artillery young officers final live firing exercise (AS90 and light gun) uses Larkhill Ranges and the Defence Logistics School exercise TIMBER TRUSS with 80 heavy logistic transport vehicles will operate combat logistic patrols across the whole Plain. Headquarters 1 Mechanised Brigade deploys onto the Plain on 28 November for two weeks with its logistic support regiment, close support REME battalion, medical regiment and Royal Military Police regiment in 25 armoured and 240 wheeled vehicles

**Note.** Vehicle movement may cause delays at tank crossings and drivers are advised to take care when approaching crossings as mud clearance parties and mechanical sweepers will be at work.

**Live Firing.** Firing is closely managed to ensure that legal noise limits are not exceeded and disturbance is minimised. Although some may find the noise intrusive, it is well below legal limits.

Access to Salisbury Plain is regulated by Salisbury Plain Military Lands and Bulford, Larkhill and Imber Range Byelaws. This Newsletter is published up to 6 weeks before the event and urgent training bids may come in subsequently. **Always comply with local signs and flags.**

**Access timings can be found on the SPTA Walks Line: (01980) 67 4763**

**Bulford Ranges.** Rights of Way (PROW) through Bulford Ranges are closed when red flags are flying. No firing is planned for 5th, 6th, 12th, 13th, 26th, 27th<sup>th</sup> November.

**Larkhill Ranges.** Rights of Way (PROW) through Larkhill Ranges are closed when red flags are flying. No firing is planned for 5th, 6th, 19th, 20th 26th, 27th, November

Note. In the event of range fires access may be denied to some areas due to the risk of unexploded ordnance "cooking off".

**Imber.** Difficult terrain and unexploded military debris make it hazardous to leave the marked routes. The public are excluded from Imber Ranges at all times, even if flags are not flying. The only exception being when the roads through Imber are opened to allow the public to reduce journey times across Imber Ranges.
