Recipe of the Month

CHICKEN THIGH BAKE WITH LEEK, POTATO & PARMESAN

An economical, easy dish, loved-by-all! Crispy skin, meltingly delicious leeks in a cheesy sauce with a few potatoes to keep up the carbs!

SERVES 4

Oil, for greasing baking tray 4 leeks 600-700g, washed & cut into 2 cm slices/rounds 500g new potatoes, unpeeled

in 1cm thick slices

12 thyme sprigs or 1 tsp dried thyme Sea salt and ground black pepper 1 tsp Dijon mustard 100ml double cream

4 garlic cloves, sliced Preheat the oven to 220 degrees/Gas7.

8 chicken thighs, skin on, bone in, 150ml chicken stock (cube is fine)

3 heaped tbs grated Parmesan



Grease a large, shallow roasting tin about 41 x 26cm and 4cm deep.

Put the leeks, potatoes, garlic, half the thyme sprigs/dried in the tin and season. Mix well, then shake the tin to level them out. Space the chicken thighs out on top and then scatter the skin with a light sprinkling of salt. Pour in the stock, avoiding the chicken. Cook at the top of the oven for 45 mins until the chicken skin is golden and crispy.

Meanwhile, mix the mustard and cream together with a little seasoning. The cream may thicken up a bit which is fine.

Remove the tin from the oven and spoon or blob the cream sauce over the vegetables, avoiding the chicken, and gently nestling it in with a spoon. Don't worry if it's not all amalgamated. Scatter the parmesan over it all, then return to the oven for a further 10 mins or until golden and crispy. Scatter with the remaining thyme sprigs just before serving.

Serve from the tin.

NOTE: You can make to the end of step 3 up to 2 days in advance, cool, cover and chill, keeping mustard mix separate. Add mixture and heat until piping hot.



I recently published my Annual Report for 2023-24 which I hope you will find is an informative summary of the work undertaken this year. The report highlights a 16.6% drop in anti-social behaviour incidents in 2023/2024 compared to 2022/2023, and a 13.4% reduction in domestic abuse related crimes, across all Neighbourhood Policing areas in the same time frame.

Another milestone was achieved this year, with Wiltshire Police removed from His Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary, Fire and Rescue Service's Engage process. Alongside this, the Force has also received a promising HMIC Police Effectiveness, Efficiency and Legitimacy (PEEL) report. The Chief Constable and I approach these with cautious optimism.

Our goal is to ensure these improvements are felt at grassroots level, so everyone can experience a genuine sense of security, rather than just being reassured by statistics. Working together, we continue to restore trust and confidence in our policing service.

The first draft of a refreshed Police and Crime Plan for 2025-29,has been published. I want to encourage residents to submit their feedback on the plan before the final version is published later this year. See the full Annual Report https://forms.office.com/pages/responsepage.aspx??
