Enford Village Hall, with its own 5 acre site, is located on the edge of this rural Wiltshire village. Facing south providing uninterrupted views across the River Avon. The ground source heat pump provides underfloor heating plus hot water for two sports teams with lowest possible CO2 emissions. Sunpipes, dual flushing WCs, timed aerated taps and showerheads, together with motion sensors for lighting, have also been installed.
